CLEAN AIR FOR SUSTAINABLE CITY IN TIRANA MUNICIPALITY

Project summary

The project "Clean Air for Sustainable City" Project will be implemented in the Tirana Municipality by fostering the participation of youths in local green projects and air and noise quality monitoring. This combined approach will be an added value of the project where mainly urban issues will be considered by the involvement of new professionals from environmental and urban engineering. The overall goal of the project is to engage young professionals in cooperation with environmental experts in air and noise monitoring and to propose successful models in achieving the 11th sustainable development objective for the city of Tirana.

Scope and objectives of the project

- Engagement and mobilization of 20 students from the Department of Environmental and Urban Planning in the realization of 4 topics related to transport, green space, urban planning
- Air and noise monitoring in 4 main points in the city of Tirana through certified methods;
- Promotion of 'green' initiatives to various actor such as students, students and specialists of Tirana Municipality in order to achieve the objectives of sustainable development.

Result of the project

- Preparation of the work plan for project implementation in cooperation with project coordinators and UNDP representatives.
- Participation of **20 students** from environmental sciences and urban development;
- Preparation of **7 workshops** by students with topics related to transport, urban green space, circulating economy and urban planning models that focus on environmental protection;
- Production of **one handbook** with work of the students. It will be printed in 50 copies.
- Production of **one banner** and **one logo** for the project;
- Preparation of the report with the result of air quality and noise in 4 points defined in Tirana. Attached to this report will be 4 maps in GIS (a map will be for air quality (in three seasons) and another for noises);
- Inclusion of **60 pupils** in awareness and information programs on clean air and noise reduction in the city;
- Realization of the campaign "For my city, for my health", where will be planted **50 trees** in the areas where the air monitoring was carried out in order to promote the green spaces;
- Realization of **100 brochures** that will contain information on the air and noise situation in Tirana and pupils' awareness on these methods;
- Informing citizens on the importance of reducing air and noise pollution through the construction and realization of **1 awareness-spot**;
- Participation in **1 TV shows** to talk and discuss the findings of the study and the measures that should be taken by the citizens / local government to achieve the project objectives;
- Realization of the **final conference** with the participation of 50 persons from the Municipality of Tirana, universities, etc.
